PURPOSE: Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) is seeking Bids from qualified contractors to complete all work required for the Melbourne King Center for the Performing Arts Lobby Renovation located on the Melbourne Campus at 3865 N Wickham Road, Melbourne, FL 32935.

1. **CONTACT:** All questions regarding this bid must be directed in writing to the Project Coordinator and Procurement Services. All prospective bidders are hereby instructed not to contact any member of the District Board of Trustees, or Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) staff regarding this bid, other than the noted contact persons below, prior to posting of a recommendation of award. Any such contact may be cause for disqualification.

2. **BID SUBMITTAL INFORMATION:** Bidder will submit one (1) original and (2) copies of the BID, complete with all supporting documentation (as required). BIDs must be received before July 9, 2019 at 2:00 pm. EFSC will only receive BIDs at the following location:

The terms “vendor”, “bidder”, “responder”, “firm”, “company” or “contractor” used in this Invitation to Bid (ITB) or any subsequent documents or communications related to this BID are interchangeable and mean the entity submitting a BID and seeking to enter into a contract for the goods and/or services requested herein.

3. **TERM OF CONTRACT:** A purchase order or contract will be established resulting from this Invitation to Bid (ITB). Any and all legal actions associated with this ITB and/or the resultant purchase order or contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida.
4. **DUE DATE, TIME AND LOCATION:** The date, time and location will be carefully observed. BIDs received after the specified date and time shall be returned unopened. EFSC will not be responsible for late deliveries or delayed mail. BIDs received that fail to provide the information required in section 2 above on the outside of the envelope/container shall result in the rejection of the submitted BID.
5. **ADDENDUM NOTIFICATION:** All addenda will be posted to the Procurement Services portion of the EFSC website at <http://www.easternflorida.edu>.
6. **PUBLIC OPENING/EVALUATION:** BIDs will be publicly opened, read and recorded on the date and time specified herein unless changed by addendum. A BID may not be altered after the opening of the BID(s).
7. **AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS:** The obligations of the College under this award are subject to the availability of funds lawfully appropriated annually for its purposes by the Legislature of the State of Florida.
8. **DELAYS:** EFSC, at its sole discretion, may delay the scheduled due dates indicated above if it is to the advantage of EFSC to do so. EFSC will notify bidders of all changes in scheduled due dates by posted addendum.
9. **BID WITHDRAWAL:** Bidders may withdraw their BIDs by notifying EFSC in writing at any time prior to the time set for the BID deadline. Bidders may withdraw their BIDs in person or through an authorized representative. Bidders and authorized representatives must disclose their identity (bidder business card and driver’s license) and provide a signed receipt for the BID. Once opened, BID(s) become the property of EFSC and will not be returned to the bidders.
10. **INQUIRIES:** All bidders shall carefully examine the BID documents. Any ambiguities or inconsistencies shall be brought to the attention of EFSC in writing; failure to do so, on the part of the bidder, will constitute an acceptance by the bidder of any subsequent decision. Any questions concerning the intent, meaning and interpretations of the BID documents shall be requested in writing or asked at the pre-BID conference. Responses to questions pertaining to this BID will be posted on the Procurement section of the EFSC website. EFSC will not be responsible for any oral instructions made by any employee(s) of EFSC in regard to this BID.

11. **REVISIONS AND AMENDMENTS:** EFSC reserves the right to revise or amend the terms, conditions and specifications or both prior to the date set for opening of the BID, such revisions and amendments, if any, will be announced by an addendum to the BID.
12. **BID PREPARATION COSTS:** EFSC shall not be liable for any expenses incurred in connection with the preparation of a response to this BID.
13. **ACCURACY OF BID INFORMATION:** Any bidder who submits in its BID to EFSC any information which is determined to be substantially inaccurate, misleading, exaggerated, or incorrect, shall be disqualified from consideration.
14. **PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES:** In accordance with F.S. 287.133, any bidder who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a BID, Bid, or reply. See Attachment D.
15. **ADVERTISING:** In submitting a BID, the Bidder agrees not to use the results as a part of any commercial advertising unless permission is granted in writing by the College.
16. **PUBLIC RECORDS:** Any material submitted in response to this Invitation to BID will become a public document pursuant to the Florida Statutes, Chapter 119. This includes materials, which the responder might consider confidential or a trade secret. Any claim of confidentiality is waived upon submission, effective upon submission of BID pursuant to the Florida Statutes, Chapter 119.
17. **JOINT VENTURES:** BIDs submitted by firms under “joint venture” arrangements or other multi-party agreements must submit a power of attorney delegating authority to one principal with authority to negotiate and execute any/all contract documents resulting from negotiations/award of this BID.
18. **DISPUTES & PROTESTS:** Per F.S.120.57 (3)(b) “Any person who is adversely affected by the agency decision or intended decision shall file with the agency a notice of protest in writing within 72 hours after the posting of the notice of decision or intended decision. With respect to a protest of the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in a solicitation, including any provisions governing the methods for ranking BIDs, Bids, or replies, awarding contracts, reserving rights of further negotiation, or modifying or amending any contract, the notice of protest shall be filed in writing within 72 hours after the posting of the solicitation. The formal written protest shall be filed within 10 days after the date the notice of protest is filed. Failure to file a notice of protest or failure to file a formal written protest shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under this chapter. The formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based. Saturdays, Sundays, and state holidays shall be excluded in the computation of the 72-hour time periods provided by this paragraph.” A protest will be filed with the Director of Procurement Services or the Manager, Procurement/Risk.

19. **IDENTICAL OR TIE BIDS:** In the event two (2) or more bidders submit the same price, the following criteria, in order of importance, shall be used to break said tie: (1 Business is within Brevard County), (2) Florida business, or (3) by flip of coin, when all other factors are equal.
20. **FAMILIARITY WITH LAWS:** All bidders are required to comply with all Federal, State, and Local laws, codes, rules and regulations controlling the action or operation of this BID.
21. **MINORITY PARTICIPATION:** It is EFSC's intent to solicit broad participation by minority firms in its construction contracts. Vendors are strongly encouraged to use minority sub-contractors, vendors and suppliers. EFSC has a progressive diversity procurement initiative, which offers equal access and opportunity to participate in all aspects of the EFSC's contracting and procurement programs.
22. **CONFLICT OF INTEREST:** The award hereunder is subject to the provisions of Chapter 112, Florida Statutes. All bidders must disclose with their BID the name of any officer, director, or agent who is also an employee of EFSC. Further, all bidders must disclose the name of any EFSC District Board Member who owns, directly or indirectly, an interest of five percent (5%) or more in the bidder's firm or any of its branches.
23. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:** Any special conditions and specifications attached here to which vary from these general conditions shall have precedence.
24. **ANTI-DISCRIMINATION:** The bidder certifies they are in compliance with the non-discrimination clause in Section 202, Executive Order 11246, as amended by executive order 11375, relative to equal employment opportunity for all persons without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin.
25. **ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTIONS:** EFSC reserves the right to reject all BIDs, to waive any informalities and technicalities, and to solicit and re-advertise for new BIDs, or to abandon the project in its entirety. EFSC reserves the right to reject the BID of any bidder who has previously failed in the proper performance of an award or to deliver the contract on time.
26. **AFFIRMATION:** By submission of a BID, bidder affirms the BID is made without prior understanding, agreement or connection with any corporation, firm, or person submitting a BID for the same materials, supplies, equipment or services, and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud. Bidder agrees to abide by all conditions of this BID and the resulting contract.
27. **WARRANTIES AND GUARANTEES:** See Attachment A.
28. **SAFETY:** The Bidder is expected to comply with all related safety standards imposed by the Florida Department of Labor and OSHA.
29. **FINGERPRINTING:** Contractor personnel may be required to have a level 2 background check (fingerprinting) dependent upon location of services provided.

30. **CONTACT:** Respondents to this solicitation or persons acting on their behalf may not contact, between the release of the solicitation and the end of the 72-hour period following the agency posting the notice of intended award, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and state holidays, any employee or officer of the executive or legislative branch concerning any aspect of this solicitation, except in writing to the procurement officer or as provided in the solicitation documents. Violation of this provision may be grounds for rejecting a response.
31. **INSURANCE:** Comprehensive General Liability required in the contract shall include contractual liability, personal injury liability, property damage and products liability. The definition of products hazard shall be amended by endorsement to delete the requirement for the injury and damage to occurrence away from premises.

These policies shall contain a covenant requiring thirty (30) days written notice to the Director of Procurement Service before cancellation, reduction or other modification of coverage. In the event that the Contractor fails to maintain and keep in force the insurance and Worker's Compensation is herein required by contract to be provided, the College shall have the right to cancel and terminate the contract forthwith and without notice. The Contractor shall advise each insuring agency to automatically renew all policies and coverage in force at the start of and resulting from this contract until notified coverage requirements are revised. Insurance certificates indicating the required minimum coverage and signed by Florida Resident Agent shall be furnished by the Contractor prior to contract award and forwarded to the Director of Procurement Services.

The Contractor shall indemnify, keep and hold harmless and defend the District Board of Trustees of Eastern Florida State College and its employees and agents against any and all liability, claims and cost of whatsoever kind and nature for injury to or death of any person or persons and for loss or damage to any property (College or otherwise) occurring in connection with or in any way incident to or arising out of the occupancy, use service, operations, or performance of work in connection with this contract, resulting in whole or part from the negligent or intentional acts of omissions of Contractor, or employee(s), agent(s) or representative of Contractor.

The Contractor shall bear the full responsibility for all risk, loss, or equipment damage, including that owned or leased by the College and for money or product loss resulting from vandalism or theft, caused by contractor or its employee(s).

32. CONSIDERATION OF BIDS: The College will award the contract to the Bidder(s) that the College deems to offer the best overall bid. In addition, the College at its sole discretion, reserves the right to cancel this ITB, to reject any and all bids, to waive any and all informalities and/or irregularities, to re-advertise with either the identical or revised specifications, or not award a contract at all if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the College to do so. The College also reserves the right to make multiple or split awards if it is deemed to be in the College's best interest. It must be specifically understood that this Invitation-To-Bid does not create any obligation on the part of Eastern Florida State College to enter into any contract or undertake any financial obligation with respect to the program referred to herein. The College also reserves the right to award by individual item, group of terms, "All or None" or any combination thereof, with one or more suppliers. Please note any items that are quoted as part of a bundle.
33. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS: The College will consider various factors in determining the best responsible bid, including but not limited to, past performance with the College, experience, financial stability, resources to perform the work, coordination with the Contractor performing with the King Center HVAC Renovation project, the ability to meet the specifications and time frame to complete the order. The College reserves the right to deem a bid unresponsive for those bidders who have previously failed in performance of an award or who have failed to deliver a contract within the time required by the College.
34. ADA: The supplier awarded this bid shall agree to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA of 1990).
35. EVALUATION PROCESS: The College will evaluate all responsive bids received and determine how effectively it satisfies the ITB.

CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITY

SCOPE OF WORK: Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) is seeking Bids from qualified contractors to complete all work required for the Melbourne King Center for the Performing Arts Lobby Renovation located on the Melbourne Campus at 3865 N Wickham Road., Melbourne, FL 32935. All plans and specifications for this project are detailed in the files to be downloaded.

The intent of this project is to improve circulation and flow of the pre-function spaces of the Melbourne King Center for the Performing Arts while replacing and updating the interior finishes.

Within this scope of work, the existing first floor bar areas will be relocated to improve queuing and circulation. Existing furnishings, finishes and signage at the first floor lobby and the second floor Crown Club will be replaced. A security vestibule will be added to the front of the building to relocate existing security equipment outside of the main circulation path alleviating congestion. Mechanical, electrical and plumbing modifications to support the above objectives are included in this scope of work. No modifications to occupancy or egress are being made.

1. Publish a statement notifying employees that the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession, or use of a controlled substance is prohibited in the workplace and specifying the actions that will be taken against employees for violations of such prohibition.
2. Inform employees about the dangers of drug abuse in the workplace, the business's policy of maintaining a drug-free workplace, any available drug counseling, rehabilitation, and employee assistance programs, and the penalties that may be imposed upon employees for drug abuse violations.
3. Give each employee engaged in providing the commodities or contractual services that are proposed a copy of the statement specified in subsection (1).
4. In the statement specified in subsection (1), notify the employees that as a condition of working on the commodities or contractual services that are under BID, the employee will abide by the terms of the statement, and will notify the employer of any conviction of, or plea of guilty or nolo contendere, to any violation of Chapter 893, or any controlled substance law of the United States or any state violation occurring in the workplace, no later than five (5) days after such conviction.
5. Impose a sanction on or require the satisfactory participation in a drug abuse assistance or rehabilitation program, if such is available in the employee's community, by an employee who is so convicted.
6. Make a good faith effort to continue to maintain a drug free workplace through implementation of this section
