- 2. Please verify Required Permits:
 - A. Is the City of Gainesville Jurisdiction Yes/No?
 - B. State Fire Marshal Per page 12 of the ITB, the SFM's approval is applied and paid for via Architect/Owner and Contractor responsible for inspections only.
 - A. Yes. The City of Gainesville is the jurisdiction. The contractor is responsible for obtaining and paying for any and all permitting required, including any other drawings, design or engineering which may be needed for those permits, to fully complete this project.
 - B. Yes.

Greenhouses are classified in the (FBC) Florida Building Code as a Utility and Miscellaneous Structure and are not exempted from a building permit. Who will provide any structural engineering compliance documents most likely required to be submitted for permit?
