<u>Answer #2:</u> The staging area is a Lee County owned property, (Parcel: 19-46-24-05-00000.0100) with a boat ramp, dock, access to water, and lockable gate. The staging property is accessed through San Carlos Island Maritime Park.

Question #3: If not, is there a public ramp or designated launch area nearby that is approved for this type of operation? Or does the contractor have to find a ramp on his own?

Answer #3: The nearest public ramp is Frizzell-Kontinos Punta Rassa public boat ramp, 18700 McGregor Blvd, Fort Myers.
