Dear Prospective Contractor:

The enclosed information has been provided for consideration in the preparation of your response to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Solicitation No. 2014018C, entitled "Invitation to Bid (ITB) for Janitorial Services for the Central and West End Operations on the Cross Florida Greenway", issued on February 4, 2014.

All responses to the subject solicitation must be received no later than 3:00 P.M. (ET) on Friday, February 28, 2014. A response received after the exact time specified will not be considered. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes (F.S.). Written notices, formal requests and proceedings must conform with the requirements set forth in Chapter 28-110, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Protests must be filed with the Procurement Section, Department of Environmental Protection, Douglas Building, Room 438, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, MS#93, Tallahassee, Florida 32399 within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes and Chapter 28-110, Florida Administrative Code.

Any person who files an action protesting a decision or intended decision pertaining to contracts administered by the DEP pursuant to Section 120.57(3), F.S. shall post with the DEP at the time of filing the formal written protest a bond payable to the DEP in an amount equal to 1 percent (1%) of the estimated contract amount as determined pursuant to Section 287.042(2)(c), Florida Statutes, which bond shall be conditioned upon the payment of all costs which may be adjudged against him in the administrative hearing in which the action is brought and in any subsequent appellate court proceeding. In lieu of a bond, the DEP may accept a cashier's check or money order in the amount of the bond. <u>FAILURE TO FILE THE PROPER BOND AT THE TIME OF FILING THE FORMAL PROTEST</u>, WILL RESULT IN A DENIAL OF THE PROTEST.

Question #1:	What is the current contract number?	
Answer #1:	DEP Contract No. GM136	
Question #2:	Can you provide the previous bid price tab including the successful bidder from the last bid opening.	
Answer #2:	Please see attached Exhibit II, Previous Bid Tabulation.	
Question #3:	Who is current contractor providing service at these facilities, how long has the current provider had the contract?	
Answer #3:	Peebles Cleaning Service	
Question #4:	What is the precise contract value for the most recent twelve month period of each facility? Is this contract value including the cost of supplies?

week (8 a.m. to 12 p.m), can these times be extended?

Answer #7: Yes, this may be discussed with the DEP Contract Manager and final decision

will be at DEP Contract Manager's discretion.

Question #8: Attachment D, floor cleaning rates, states "both locations" whereas Attachment

C, Section II, item B4, lists three (3) locations, which is correct?

Answer #8: Per Attachment C, Section II, Item B.4, there are three (3) locations, Inglis

Office, Sharpes Ferry Office, and Santos Campground/Gatehouse.

Question #9: What is the square footage of the buildings to be cleaned?

Answer #9: Please see Answer #1 to Roseann HoShing, above.

Question #10: Has the service provider fulfilled the contract obligations?

Answer #10: Yes

Question #11: With regard to consumables, what is the rate of usage and costs? If not known,

is it possible to get the information from the current provider?

Answer #11: The rates for this Contract were on a per day basis. We do not keep a record of

the supply usage.
