Note:

As clarification, the additional plans that were provided in Addendum Two (2), dated July 12, 2018, were provided for reference only. These plans, labeled “Honeymoon Island State Park – Relocation of Bathhouse #3 & #4 (DEP Project #60530)” with a date of August 2004 on the cover sheet, were provided to show the approximate location of utilities in the area. Specifically, the patch in the road at the intersection near the Nature Center. These plans have already been constructed. The present-day Nature Center used to be Bathhouse #4 and was moved to its current location per the plans. No actual improvements based off those plans should be included in a contractor’s bid.

As clarification, the Asbestos & Lead Containing Paint Survey from Addendum Three (3), dated July 23, 2018, was provided because the Roadway Repair project involves demolition of select materials. Page 4 of the survey, 1.1 Introduction & 1.2 Facility Description, describe what areas were tested. Contractors may ignore reference to “ADA Boardwalk Reconstruction Project” as this is a separate project. Contractors should note results from section 2.0 Asbestos and 3.0 Lead-Containing Paint. No asbestos containing materials were found in the samples taken, but Table 3.2-1 indicates the yellow “Lane Designation Stripe on Asphalt” did test positive for lead paint. This survey was provided so contractors may include in their bids any necessary pre-cautions for dealing with demolition of lead containing materials.

In all other respects, the contract documents of which this is an Addendum, and attachments relative thereto, shall remain in full force and effect.
