For each sub-consultant, the Appraiser shall submit the name and address of the sub-consultant and secure prior approval from the Department to employ the sub-consultant(s)"
At which stage of the negotiation process are we to submit the names and addresses of the sub-consultant(s) to the Department for approval? Are they to be included in the ITN noted above?
