I know that is usually made available but sometimes we need to go through a specific channel to retrieve that. Can you please advise the best way to attain that?
Answer #1	This is the first time we have bid these items, previously they were only quoted.
Question #2	I am mostly interested in the 12oz vinyl product. Any bid history/tabulation information that is available would be greatly appreciated.
Answer #2	Please see response to Question #1.
Question #3	On Item 8- What color is the elastic?
Answer #3	White.
Question #4	Who was awarded the last contract and what were the prices?
Answer #4	Please see response to Question #1.
Question #5	When was your last purchase?
Answer #5	12/1/2015
Question #6	What were the amounts each site ordered?

Question #8	On items 5 and 6, what is the amounts listed? Yards or spools?
Answer #8	Item 5 is 12K (12,000) yards/cone (spool) and the anticipated annual usage is 2,220 cones (spools). Item 6 is 12K (12,000) yards/cone (spool) and the anticipated annual usage is 1,211 cones (spools).
Question #9	Is this contract being awarded to one vendor?

Answer #9	Yes. Per Section 5.8, Basis of Award, a single award shall be made to the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder offering the Lowest Grand Total Bid Price for the items indicated in this ITB.
Question #10	Will all items on bid be ordered by all the sites listed?

Answer #11	The sites in response to Question #10 ordered all items.
Question #12	What was the last item ordered and what was the quantity?
Answer #12	17 rolls of white striping, 400 yds postman blue twill, 400 yds postman blue poplin.
Question #13	What are the specifications for Item # 7 Thread Nylon Mattress Thread, What is the Tex Size? Color? Is it Bonded? Size of put-up?
Answer #13	BZT nylon bonded #46 – 16 oz – tube – white.
Question #14	On item 1: we've used red and orange twill in the past when these colors of poplin aren't available. These colors are a very small portion of the twill requirement. I believe FSP is the requestor for them. Will that still be an option if these two colors are found to be cost prohibitive in poplin? I don't want the small portions of red and orange to skew the pricing for the blue and white poplin.
Answer #14	Yes, red & orange twill can be substituted for poplin, if unavailable.
Question #15	Also noted that items 3 and 10 are requesting a higher grade product than FDC currently uses. Specs are intertwined for two different fabrics. Are we allowed to quote both options for these items or bid items that are currently in use? Item 3 should be white sheeting T130 5-/50 poly cotton blend. 65" cuttable Item 10 should be grey vinyl 7 oz, 100 yd roll rest is fine.
Answer #15	Please see revisions to Attachment 1, Price Page, for Item 3. The specification is correct for Item 10. Please quote as specified.

	what is the tex number, is it bonded or soft, and what color do you need
Answer #16	Please see response to Question #13.
Question #17	Can we bid on each item separately ?Not bid on every item ,is it ok?
Answer #17	No. Please see response to Question #9.
Question #18	Could you tell us the minimum quantity you required for each item and Shall we delivery all products in one time or deliver in several times separately? And how many locations you referred in attachment 3 should we deliver to ?

Answer #18	Per Section 3.8, Minimum Order, the Department intends that the minimum order that shall be placed under the resultant Contract shall be \$250.00. Delivery dates are determined each time an order is placed and may be for one shipment or several. Question #21	About item 5 and item 6 ,for thread ,could you tell us the purpose of the product ? Is it same as sewing thread ,used in sewing ?or other else ?
Answer #21	It is used as sewing thread to manufacture inmate clothing and other items using items #1, #2, #3, and #4.
Question #22	About item 4,for mesh fabric ,could you tell me the purpose of the product ?Used In making cloth or laundry bag? And what is the hole shape ?
Answer #22	The material is used for making laundry bags. The current hole shape is hexagon but as long as the holes are 1/4" the hole shape will not matter.
