PROVIDING QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTION 1:

What is the maximum mooring load that each buoy must support while maintaining the minimum height of visibility?

ANSWER:

We have no requirement on this. This is the first I've heard of this.

QUESTION 2:

In a normal mooring situation, what is the minimum visual area for each buoy type?

ANSWER:

I'm not sure of this question. The viewing area is the entire circumference of the buoy based on its size specifications which is in the bid.

QUESTION 3:

Is a registration with Sunbiz necessary for the bid?

ANSWER:

To be a responsible vendor within this process, yes, you must register in MyFloridaMarketPlace. However, only if you are a Florida based business do you have to be listed in SunBiz. Out of State businesses do not have to register in SunBiz.

QUESTION 4:

Will a fork lift be required at any/all delivery locations?

ANSWER:

This is already in the bid. Freight on Board. The shipping company must be able to deliver the buoys within whatever Facility we are shipping to. It doesn't specify a forklift but if that is what it takes to get the job done then the shipping company needs to anticipate this.

QUESTION 5:

What types of insurance do you require verification of?

ANSWER:

Insurance Required for Performance. During the Contract term, Contractor shall maintain any other types and forms of insurance required for the performance of this Contract. Additional insurance requirement may also be found in the Scope of Work. Please see bid for more information regarding this matter.

QUESTION 6:

Is enrollment in E-Verify required for this bid?

ANSWER:

Enrollment in E-Verify. If Contractor does not have an E-Verify MOU in effect, the Contractor must enroll in the E-Verify system prior to hiring any new employee after the effective date of this Contract.

QUESTION 7:

What certification is needed to verify that materials will meet the specifications in the bid?

ANSWER:

I don't understand this question. Certification that it will meet the specs? You either meet the specs or not.
