#### **Item #1: Questions and Answers**

**Question #1:** Quarterly Minority and Service-Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise Reports are shown as being required. Please confirm that these will need to be submitted even though this contract would be for the purchase of goods and will not include sub-contractors.

**Answer #1:** No reporting will be required due in the event that no subcontractors be utilized for this procurement.

### Question #2 Bid Spec. Vessels I. thru VI.:

If the bimini top is located as requested "in a way that covers both console and operator", it will possibly need to lay down towards the bow or be installed with a slide track or an additional set of mounts. Is there a preference if the top will not lay down in the aft and still cover the requested area?

#### Answer #2:

We are ok with the top folding forward if, this is the only way to mount it to cover the driver at standing at the console or sitting at the seat. It would appear this will only be an issue on the smaller vessels.

#### Question #3 Bid Spec. Vessels I. thru VI.:

We have not previously offered "Side Boxes for Weapons Storage", but we have had several Center Mounted Bow Step Storage & Weapons Boxes" ordered and installed. The side mount boxes are going to make it very tight to walk around the console. Do you want us to quote the center mounted that we have offered, the side boxes as requested, or both?

Please quote the side boxes as requested on the price sheet. Any additional options would be purchased using the percentage discount off as outlined on the price sheet.

#### Question #4 Bid Spec. Vessel VI.:
