A claimant who is not in privity with the Contractor and who has not received payment for his or her labor, materials, or supplies shall deliver to the Contractor and to the Surety written notice of the performance of the labor or delivery of the materials, or supplies and of the nonpayment. The notice of nonpayment may be served at any time during the progress of the work or thereafter but not before 45 days after the first furnishing of labor, services, or materials, and not later than 90 days after the final furnishing of the labor, services, or materials by the claimant or, with respect to rental equipment, not later than 90 days after the date that the rental equipment was last on the job site available for use. No action for the labor, materials, or supplies may be instituted against the Contractor or the Surety unless both notices have been given. Notices required or permitted may be served in accordance with s. 713.18. An action, except for an action exclusively for recovery of retainage, must be instituted against the Contractor or the Surety on the payment bond or the payment provisions of a combined payment and performance bond within 1 year after the performance of the labor or completion of delivery of the materials or supplies. An action must be instituted against the Contractor or the Surety within 1 year after the performance of the labor or completion of delivery of the materials or supplies, or within 90 days after receipt of final payment (or the payment estimate containing the Department's final reconciliation of quantities if no further payment is earned and due as a result of deductive adjustments) by the Contractor or Surety, whichever comes last. The time periods for service of a notice of nonpayment or for bringing an action against a Contractor or a Surety shall be measured from the last day of furnishing labor, services, or materials by the claimant. FDOT ORLANDO OPERATIONS COMPLEX 420 LANDSTREET ROAD ORLANDO, FL 32824

I. OBJECTIVE:

The Florida Department of Transportation is seeking quotes to repair gas and diesel lines/connections; remove and replace transitioning sump to include all required internal components therein at the Orlando Operations Complex. All work must comply with current FDEP requirements. Contractor responsibilities include acquiring required permits, notifications, and inspections.

II. SCOPE OF WORK

Secure work area, notify local DEP inspector of work being performed, acquire all required permits, procure inspections as necessary, supply all material, labor and parts needed to complete work as specified.

Blow back both gas and diesel lines to remove fuel from lines and disconnect product piping.

Saw cut, breakout and remove concrete from around transitioning sump, remove existing transitioning sump, check the removed transitioning sump and the ground to ensure fuel did not leak into the soil, cut back both gas and diesel lines, install new fiberglass transition sump, install new piping and entry boots, remove and replace 120vac solenoid and ball valve to the diesel line. Once the new transition sump has been completely installed and piped, pressure test both gas and diesel lines to ensure compliance with FDEP regulations. After a completed and passing pressure test, drill rebar and pour and finish concrete around new transition sump.

Saw cut, breakout and remove concrete from around fuel dispensers #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, and #6 on the pump island south side, dispensers #1, #2, #3, #4, #5 and #6 on the pump island north side. Accessing the sumps from the outside, cut out all entry boots from both sides, clean and prep areas. Install new entry boots and test boots. After all entries are made and glue has dried, hydro test all dispenser and transition sumps.

Once the hydro test has been completed and passed, backfill around dispensers, drill rebar, pour and finish concrete. Match existing concrete thickness. Minimum concrete strength: 3000 PSI @ 28 days.
