Eligibility Requirements

- SFAs that currently participate in the NSLP
- High need schools with limited access to resources and age of food service equipment
- 50% or more of the enrolled students at the school are eligible for free and reduced price meals

- Submission Deadline March 27, 2020 no later than 4PM Eastern Time (ET)
- Evaluation of Applications
 March 30 May 14, 2020
- Award notice to sponsors May 21, 2020
- Purchases must be made by September 30, 2021
