# **Questions and Answers (Part 1)**

#### Question 1.

Please provide the model number that the specifications are from.

#### Answer 1.

The scope of work was created based on an Acker PT-22 and Simco 255 Pavement Test Core. We set the scope to meet the specifications of both models.

#### Question 2.

The first item is with this type of equipment typically one day of on-site training to cover operation of the rig and cover general maintenance is a listed equipment. Was this omitted in error?

#### Answer 2.

Onsite training was not intended to be required.

### Question 3

Specification 2.14. Our rig uses a Hydraulic Slide to adjust the vertical height position of the core guide. However, the adjustable guide from 2-12" is manual. This seems like two specs were combined in error.

#### Answer 3

The intent is not for the adjustment to the core barrel guide due to using different diameter core barrels (2-12") to be hydraulically adjustable. Manual adjustments to the core barrel guide are allowed due to the core barrel diameter.

## Question 4

For clarification of the instate preference form to be accompanied by a signed opinion by an attorney, do you have an example of a completed opinion from out of state that has no preference?

### **Answer 4**
