To be eligible for award:

Bidders must provide an annual per person rate for all Covered Personnel Codes except for Code G, Militia.

For Covered Personnel Code G, Militia, each bidder is required to submit a daily rate per militia member. Militia numbers are reported as man-days.

A bidder may provide pricing for either Policy Period 1; Policy Periods 1 and 2; Policy Periods 1, 2 and 3; or Policy Periods 1, 2, 3 and 4. No other combination of Policy Periods will be accepted.

Premium pricing must be based upon current deductibles.

Bidders not submitting pricing for any Policy Period 2, 3 or 4 shall not input any data into those pricing fields.

Bids for multiple Policy Periods shall be discounted in accordance with Section 2.2.14 of the ITB. (Awarded Bidder will be paid the Total Premium Including Any Assessments or Fees)

Bidders not submitting pricing for Policy Periods 2, 3 or 4 should not input any data into those pricing fields; pricing fields are coded for a numeric response, and anything other than a numeric response will render an error code in the Calculated Premium cell. Non conforming price sheets may be deemed non-responsive.
