WORK DESCRIPTION:

District-Wide Public Title Search Services in District Six for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

I. BELOW PLEASE FIND THE ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS ON THIS PROJECT:

- a. **Question:** Can you please tell us if there was a change in the terms or scope between the original RFP and the REBID?

Answer: The change of Scope of Services was to remove e-title since District 6 doesn't use the software, and the pay item was removed from the Price Proposal.

- b. **Question:** As a technical matter, in the previously RFP, the Department confirmed that they may or may not need the required 100+ year chain of title for every title report, yet the REBID RFP still requires that the contractor provide a chain of title dating back to the beginning of public records. How do you suggest a proposer reconcile the 100+ chain requirement with the possibility of exceptions, since there is no guarantee or percentage of exceptions provided, in order to provide a competitive price proposal?

Answer: There will be a 100+ year chain of title specifically requested or 30 years chain of title specifically requested.
