5.3.1 Scoring

The Department's Evaluators will independently evaluate each Programmatic Proposal in accordance with the following criteria:

The Vendor's articulation of its approach to providing required services and the ability to meet the requirements of this RFP and provide additional value.	35%	350
The Vendor's company structure, subcontractors, and experience and capability to deliver its proposed services including the Vendor track record providing services similar to the one specified in this RFP.	35%	350
The Vendor's company structure and the skills and experience of the Vendor's leadership team, staff, and resources the Vendor will use in implementing its services	10%	100
TOTAL	80%	800

The Department's Financial Evaluator and Procurement Manager will independently evaluate each Financial Proposal in accordance with the following criteria:

Criteria	Relative Value	Possible Points
The Vendor's financial management approach, proposed budget and related financial information.	20%	200
