This Addendum includes the Department's answers to the second round of written questions received.

This Addendum also includes the following revisions:

Change No. 1:

A change to Section 2.5, Transition and Service Implementation, to revise the below:

2.5 Transition and Service Implementation

The Vendor must have the ability to implement service delivery, as described herein, on a date agreed upon by both the Vendor and the Department. As part of its Reply to this ITN, each Vendor must provide an ~~Overall Regional Implementation Plan~~ **outline of the Vendor's Transition Plan**, including **a list of all major transition activities**, a timeline for transition at each institution, and a ~~detailed~~ **brief** description of the transition plan for delivery of in-prison substance abuse treatment services.

~~The Overall Regional Implementation Plan, which includes a list of all major transition activities, with responsible parties and timelines, must be submitted at least 30 calendar days prior to the transition begin date. The plan shall include provisions for: oversight of program management and clinical functions; human resources; quality management; financial management; reporting; licenses and permits; equipment and supplies; information technology; and target transition dates for each institution and associated satellite facilities covered by this ITN.~~

In addition, the Vendor shall:

- Meet with the Department, within ~~three~~ 10 days of Contract execution, to present a ~~Final~~ **Proposed** Transition Plan, in order to ensure an efficient and seamless transition from the current Vendors. This plan should be of greater detail than the ~~Overall Regional Implementation Plan~~ **outlined Transition Plan included with the Vendor's Reply to this ITN**, and shall include provisions for: oversight of program management and clinical functions; human resources; quality management; financial management; reporting; licenses and permits; equipment and supplies; information technology; and target transition dates for each institution and associated satellite facilities covered by this ITN.
- Provide regular reports to the Department, not less than weekly, on the status of filling positions and the transition, in general.

- Submit the Final Transition Plan to the Department for approval ~~within 15 days of Contract execution~~ **at least 30 calendar days prior to the start of transition**. The Final Transition Plan shall be designed to provide seamless transition, with minimal interruption of substance abuse treatment to inmates. Final transition at each institution shall be coordinated between the Vendor and the Department.
- Commence provision of substance abuse treatment services to the Department's inmates, consistent with the approved ~~Overall Regional Implementation Plan~~ and Final Transition Plan Schedule.
- Assume full responsibility for substance abuse treatment services within 90 days of Contract execution, or on a date agreed upon in writing between the Vendor and the Department.

During the transition period, the Department will provide access to all records, files, and documents necessary for the provision of substance abuse treatment services, including but not limited to inmate records and financial reports.

The Department reserves the right to revise the timeline, **Proposed and Final Transition Plans**, ~~Overall Regional Implementation Plan~~, and/or cancel this ITN, as it deems necessary, in its best interest, or in the best interest of the State.

Yes, any partnerships used by the Vendor to provide services under the Contract resulting from this ITN, would be considered subcontractors, and the Vendor shall be responsible for the performance of that entity, whether they are from a paid entity or volunteer-based organization.
25	PS-006 states that the Vendor shall develop individualized treatment plans and provide services which address the criminogenic needs of program participants. This individualized treatment plan terminology that is used implies that it is 65D-30 specific, meaning that it is subject to Chapter 65D-30.004(17), F.A.C. which requires treatment plan reviews and countersignature of the qualified professional. This is not a requirement of prevention licensure. Would the FDC consider changing the language of PS-006 to state an individualized program plan versus an individualized treatment plan? This would clarify responsibilities to have individualized goals for the client in prevention programming without adding additional treatment paperwork to the counseling staff that is not usually done in prevention programming.
