Written notices, formal requests and proceedings must conform with the requirements set forth in Chapter 28-110, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Protests must be filed with the Purchasing Office, Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, 2590 Executive Center Circle, Suite 100, Tallahassee, Florida 32301 within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), F.S. and Chapter 28-110, F.A.C.

QUESTION #1

Was there additional geotechnical testing done that was not provided in the original bid package?

ANSWER #1

QUESTION #2

What soil classification does the fill material labeled as backfill in the attached snip need to comply with?

ANSWER #2

The soil classification for the fill material labeled as backfill associated with the mounded drain field area shall meet AASHTO Class A-3.

QUESTION#3

Are site visits allowed any time or is there a check in required?

ANSWER#3

Site visits are allowed any time.

QUESTION #4

Can we extend work hours from 6 AM until 5:30 PM?

ANSWER #4

Yes

QUESTION #5

Do Contractors need to prequalify with FWC prior to bidding?

ANSWER #5

If a Contractor's bid submission is equal to or greater than \$200,000, then the Contractor must pre-quality with the Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission, per section B-1, Prequalification to Submit a Bid, of the General Terms and Conditions.

QUESTION #6

What are the hunt dates that the contractors cannot work?
