The Department would like to include the following information regarding the current handguns and ammunition:

The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) ITN-066-19 FHP Handguns Addendum No. 2

The current handguns are Glock 37 GAP 45 and have been in service for approximately ten (10) years. The Department considers its handguns to be in fair to good condition, with minor wear and tear from the years of service. All handguns are inspected annually, and parts are replaced per the manufacturer's armorer manuals.

The average amount of rounds fired by an individual handgun during its service life with the Department is approximately 2,500 rounds; however, a small percentage of the handguns have been fired significantly more.

There are currently 11 handguns out of service due to maintenance and/or replacement parts.

All ammunition has been stored indoors, in sealed cases of 1,000 (individual boxes of 50).
