3. New Air Handling Unit:

There were no submittals for approval of equivalents received. The new air handling unit shall be manufactured by Daikin; meeting the specifications in Section III - Statement of Work.

The ITB is revised to the extent specifically amended by this "Addendum No. 1". Otherwise, all other provisions of the ITB remain in effect.
