The Contractor will be required to perform annual maintenance and support on software currently used by the Department of Financial Services (Department). The vendor will also be required to provide new ADSync and Retention licenses, maintenance and support, which includes installation and configuration, and end-user training and documentation.

<u>Justification for single source acquisition</u> (what is necessary and unique about the product, service or source; steps taken to confirm unavailability of competition, as appropriate):

The Department originally entered into an agreement with Vista Solutions Group to provide software maintenance for the VisiFLOW document imaging system through a formal solicitation, ITB 04/05-08. In 2011, Vista Solutions Group developed netDMS as a successor to replace the aging VisiFLOW that was no longer being supported or updated by the manufacturer, Exigen Group. Vista Solutions Group further provided the migration and conversion of VisiFLOW to netDMS and developed customized software modules in 2012, 2013 and 2014 to add features that increased the functionality of the netDMS system.

The Department's Division of Accounting and Auditing, Division of Unclaimed Property, and Office of the General Counsel use the netDMS software and these customized modules for document imaging; imaged document archival, retrieval, and workflow; and the ability to search and access Final Orders via the internet. The Department has identified a continued need to purchase annual maintenance and software support for the customized document imaging system designed for the Department. Vista Solutions Group has a proprietary interest in its software that has been modified for the Department's specific use of the netDMS system. Therefore, Vista Solutions Group has represented to the Department that it is the sole source of maintenance and support for the customized netDMS software.

The Department also needs to install ADSync and Retention modules to comply with Department Security standards, and provide increased functionality. Vista Solutions Group wrote the netDMS application, and the netDMS code needs to be modified to integrate the two modules with netDMS. Vista Solutions Group is the only vendor that is able to sell and install these ADSync and Retention modules.
