REQUEST FOR APPLICATION

**RFA #120419JSET1, Child Abuse Protection Treatment Act (CAPTA) & Community-
Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP): Home Visitation for Substance-Affected
Infants and their Families**

Request for Application (RFA) #120419JSET1, CAPTA & CBCAP: Home Visitation for Substance-Affected Infants and their Families is hereby amended as follows (all changes are highlighted in yellow).

1. Page 4, Sections 1.2.4 and 1.2.5, are amended to read:

1.2.4 The Applicant may subcontract with a service provider that has an evidence-based program for early intervention and Home Visitation services for this Target Population.

1.2.5 The Applicant may subcontract the provision of direct services described herein to another entity, as consistent with their application. The Applicant retains overall grant administration and financial accountability.

2. Page 5, Section 1.3.1, is amended to read:

1.3.1 This solicitation offers funding for two types of grants: CAPTA state grant and CBCAP grant.

1.3.1.1 CAPTA State Grant

During the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, there is a total of \$1,817,707.00, subject to the availability of funds, to be divided amongst all awarded Applicants, subject to the availability of funds.

The Grant agreement may be renewed, subject to the availability of funds.

1.3.1.2 CBCAP Grant

During the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, there is a total of \$1,129,227.00, subject to the availability of funds, to be divided amongst all awarded Applicants, subject to the availability of funds.
