I. <u>BELOW PLEASE FIND THE ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM</u> <u>PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS ON THIS PROJECT:</u>

a. Question: Can a company who has FHP rotation in the Southwest bid for all zones north of their location?

Answer: Any capable wrecker company that is able to provide documentary proof of compliance with the requirements and qualifications outlined throughout the contract Scope of Services is eligible to submit a proposal to provide RISC services, and consequently may sign up to respond to incidents located within each response area outlined in Exhibit "C", Proposers Areas of Coverage.

b. Question: If District Six is divided into twelve segments will the calls be rotated per incident per segment?

Answer: The Department intends to activate RISC on a rotational basis as indicated in Section 4.4, Incident Response Requirements, of Exhibit "A", Scope of Services.

Revised documents are posted on VBS. All other documents of the subject project remain unchanged.
