The Agency's current regulatory system (LicenseEase) that is used to maintain the AHCA Hospital Licensure Database, was acquired through AHCA Contract No. M0240, which specified that VERSA Management Systems, Inc. (VERSA) owns the system code and licenses the use of the code to AHCA.

Justification for Single Source Purchase (what is necessary and unique about the commodity, contractual service, or source; steps taken to confirm unavailability of competition, as appropriate):

AHCA Contract No. M0240 specified AHCA enter into an agreement with VERSA for ongoing maintenance and support of LicenseEase software. VERSA/MicroPact is the only vendor capable of providing software upgrades, modifications, enhancements, training and support. AHCA only has rights to the software, but does not own the code. Therefore, required support and enhancements to the system involving code changes may only be performed by VERSA/MicroPact, the proprietor of LicenseEase.
