The Following statements supersede & supplement the corresponding items in the specifications & drawings:

- 1. Question: Sheet A401 is not shown in the plan set but is referenced in the specification. Is there a missing sheet?
 - **Answer:** There is no sheet A401. Delete line 2.04, A, 2 ("Signage relating to water usage. See A401") from specification section 10426 Signage.
- **2. Question:** Pro Floors Plus is interested in submitting a bid for the resinous flooring on this project. Can you confirm that we need to submit bids to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and not a general contractor? If so, what do I need to do to find out if Dur-A-Flex is an approved equal? **Answer:** DEP requires a general contractor for this project. We can provide a list of potential bidders to this subcontractor upon request.

3. Question: Architectural Specification 10155, Section 2.2, calls for Toilet-Enclosure Style: Ceiling hung. Architectural Specification 10155; Sections, 2.3, 2.5, and 3.2 describe Overhead Braced Units. Reflected Ceiling Plan notes on Architectural Drawing Sheet No. A701 call for Existing Painted Plywood [ceiling] to Remain. Please clarify the type of Toilet Enclosures desired. If Ceiling Hung Toilet Enclosures are desired, has the existing ceiling framing been evaluated and determined adequate to support Ceiling Hung style Toilet Enclosures? Or is the structural evaluation and possible removal and replacement of the existing ceiling assembly the responsibility of the contractor?

Answer: The intent is to use a floor mounted, overhead braced system. All references in specification section 10155 Toilet Compartments to 'Ceiling Hung' should be replaced with 'Overhead braced'.
