**QUESTION #1**

Cooling tower maintenance is there a lift on site to perform the maintenance as the towers are off of the ground at a significant height?

**ANSWER #1**

Lift hasn't been needed in the past for any corrective or preventative work. There is a ladder built into the side of the Cooling tower to provide access.

**QUESTION #2**

Is it possible to extend the due diligence period due to the amount of equipment and piping to go through?

**ANSWER #2**

The period may be extended to 45 days

**QUESTION #3**

At what point as it concerns rusty shafts and blower wheels do we determine replacement of equipment or component's?

**ANSWER #3**

Rust only becomes a concern when it affects performance. New rust should be cleaned and painted to prevent further corrosion as described in the Contract.
