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**I. BELOW PLEASE FIND THE ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS ON THIS PROJECT:**

**a. Question:** Items 9-2, 9-3, and 9-4 reference the repealed regulation 62-770; should these items be removed or replaced?

**Answer:** Items are to remain since some older FDEP Action Orders could still be using requirements under 62-770 FAC.

**b. Question:** Item 10-17 references Mercury; please confirm whether mercury by 245.1/7470/7471 is required or if Low Level Mercury by 1631 is required.

**Answer:** Use Method 245.1/7470/7471.

**c. Question:** There is no line item that references BTEX+MTBE (a usual standard for these programs); should we interpret line 9-16 "EPA Method 8260 – VOA" as BTEX+MTBE?

**Answer:** No change. Leave as EPA Method 8260 – VOA's
