Service Description	Unit Cost
Removal and Transportation Services	
The remains and associated artifacts and soil, exhumed from each gravesite, currently being held at USF must be transported, by land, to a funeral establishment located in Leon County, Florida as identified. Costs include:	
1) Ensuring that the remains and associated artifacts, and soil are appropriately secured for transporting.	
2) Professional and non-professional funeral home staff time to: ensure that the remains, artifacts, and soil are appropriately secured for transporting; coordinate with USF and the receiving funeral establishment as to the transport date and time; and ensure the remains are marked with a unique identifier.	
3) Use of funeral establishment service vehicles (if needed).	
4) Transporting remains to Leon County, Florida (by land transportation)	
Preparation Services	
The remains and associated artifacts and soil must be prepared for interment at a funeral establishment located in Leon County. Costs include:	
1) Professional and non-professional funeral home staff time to: Coordinate with the transportation service concerning date and time of transport and receiving, reviewing, and preparing paperwork to accept the remains;	

schedule and coordinate interment at one cemetery in Leon County; and prepare the remains for interment.	
2) Storing the remains for a period of time prior to burial (if needed).	
3) Obtaining adult sized caskets.	
Cemetery Products and Services	
The remains and associated artifacts and soil must be buried at a licensed cemetery located in Leon County, Florida. Costs include:	
1) Professional and non-professional funeral home staff time to; locate one cemetery in Leon County with capacity to designate an area specifically for the burial plots for the remains, artifacts, and soil.	
2) Obtaining burial plots within the selected cemetery.	
3) Constructing and installing burial vaults.	
4) Maintaining and landscaping the burial plots in perpetuity.	
Interment Services	
The remains and associated artifacts and soil must be interred at one cemetery, located in Leon County, Florida. Costs include:	
1) Professional and non-professional funeral home staff time to: coordinate with the Department and the cemetery to arrange interment at the cemetery; and oversee the interment at the cemetery.	
2) Transportation of the remains to the cemetery.	
3) Equipment needed at interment.	
4) Burial of the remains to include opening and closing of the graves.	
5) Temporary markers for each gravesite.
