I. <u>BELOW PLEASE FIND THE ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS ON THIS PROJECT:</u>

a. Question: Items 9-2, 9-3, and 9-4 reference the repealed regulation 62-770; should these items be removed or replaced?

Answer: Items are to remain since some older FDEP Action Orders could still be using requirements under 62-770 FAC.

b. Question: Item 10-17 references Mercury; please confirm whether mercury by 245.1/7470/7471 is required or if Low Level Mercury by 1631 is required.

Answer: Use Method 245.1/7470/7471.

c. Question: There is no line item that references BTEX+MTBE (a usual standard for these programs); should we interpret line 9-16 "EPA Method 8260 – VOA" as BTEX+MTBE?

Answer: No change. Leave as EPA Method 8260 - VOA's
