**2.8.2** In particular, applicants should note the following non-exclusive list of unallowable services under the PPG program:

- 2.8.2.1 Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) programs;
- 2.8.2.2 Enforcement of alcohol, tobacco, or other drug laws;
- 2.8.2.3 Lobbying;
- 2.8.2.4 Cash payments to intended recipients of services;
- 2.8.2.5 Mental Health First Aid and Crisis Intervention Training; and
- **2.8.2.6** Naloxone kits (though primary prevention set-aside funds can pay for overdose prevention education and training).
