Question 1	Can an AASHTO provisional standard be included in the protocols that will be developed in Task 2?
Answer 1	Yes
Question 2	Which type of aggregate should be used for the 12.5-mm mix in this project?
Answer 2	Georgia granite.
Question 3	Can the use of master curve of asphalt binders be acceptable for the binder evaluation protocol even though there is no AASHTO/ASTM standard for determining the binder master curve?
Answer 3	No, because we may let private labs perform the protocol in the future and they would need test procedures.
Question 4	Does FDOT have field sections constructed with at least two modified binders or fiber mixture additives whose field performance data can be used for validation in Task 3?
Answer 4	No.
