Typical Warning Sign Detail (C-2), Estimated Quantities (C-2), Locations (C-3, C-6, C-7)

- 1. Question:** Is it possible for the contractor to use a skiff, or shallow boat, to deploy the turbidity curtains?
Answer: Refer to FDEP Permit No. 0357653-001-EI, Specific Condition 18: Watercraft associated with the construction of the permitted structure shall operate within waters of sufficient depth to preclude bottom scouring/prop dredging.
- 2. Question:** What type of anchors are allowed for securing the turbidity curtains?
Answer: Turbidity curtain anchors must be retrievable and removed immediately following use. The Contractor's proposed anchor/mooring systems should be sufficient to anchor the turbidity barrier during anticipated wind, wave, and current conditions. Refer to the Technical Specifications Section 3.07 (D) for additional details and requirements.
- 3. Question:** What is the distance between the breakwater edge and the access corridor along the shoreline?
Answer: Refer to the Construction Drawings, Sheets C-6 and C-7.
- 4. Question:** What is the middle line between the breakwater and shoreline on the Northern end?
Answer: Proposed location of the Coir log (Bid Alternate #1). Refer to the Construction Drawings, Sheets C-2, C-6, and C-7 for plan and cross-section views of the proposed coir log.
- 5. Question:** Is it possible for the contractor to bring in floating equipment (mini-barge) from land?
Answer: Construction operations shall be land-based. There are no designated vessel-launching facilities on site and the existing conditions include shallow water that likely will not support floating equipment.
- 6. Question:** Is this project funded with federal money?
Answer: No

In all other respects, the contract documents of which this is an Addendum, and attachments relative thereto, shall remain in full force and effect.

Contractor shall provide all labor, materials, equipment, supervision and permitting to construct a "living shoreline" along approximately 1,400-ft of Apalachicola Bay shoreline in Eastpoint, Franklin County, FL. The primary component of the project includes construction of two segmented low-crested breakwaters extending to the north and south from an existing rock breakwater. The proposed breakwater shall be comprised of stone-filled, high-density polyethylene (HDPE) marine mattresses. ~~Additional project components include installation of waterway warning signs per the contract documents.~~

The Bidder further agrees that in the event of the Bidder's default or breach of any of the requirements of this proposal, the Bid Guaranty shall be forfeited as liquidated damages.
