1. Section 5.7 Subcontractors

Anticipated subcontract agreements known at the time of Proposal submission and the amount of the subcontract must be identified in the Proposal. If a subcontract has been identified at the time of Proposal submission, a copy of the proposed subcontract must be submitted to the Department with each proposal pursuant to Section 4.3.1. If there is more than one subcontract developed or proposed with the same template, the respondent may include a copy of that subcontract template with an attached list of existing or proposed providers. No subcontract that the Respondent enters into with respect to performance under the Contract will in any way relieve the Respondent of any responsibility for performance of its contractual responsibilities with the Department. The Department reserves the right to request and review information in conjunction with its determination regarding a subcontract request.
