2.	Would the Department permit further specificity regarding what constitutes a comparable contract? Such as specifying that it would be for contracts for operations and maintenance services of pension systems of substantially the same quality and quantity of services, and with the same staff requirements (e.g., skill levels and onshore-offshore ratios), schedule, and terms and conditions?
