Notice of Bid/Proposals/Negotiations Protest Bonding Requirement- any person who files an action protesting a decision or intended decision pertaining to contracts administered by the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services pursuant to Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, shall post with the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond payable to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services in an amount equal to 1 percent of the estimated contract amount, as determined pursuant to Section 287.042(2)(c), Florida Statutes, which bond shall be conditioned upon the payment of all costs, which may be adjudged against him in the hearing in which the action is brought and in any subsequent appellate court proceeding. For protest of decisions or intended decisions pertaining to exceptional purchases, the bond shall be in the amount equal to 1 percent of the estimated pursuant to Section 287.042(2)(c), Florida Statutes. In lieu of a bond, the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services may, in either case, accept a cashier's check, official bank check or money order in the amount of the bond. Failure to file the proper bond at the time of filing the formal protest will result in a denial of the protest.
