Price: \$101,535.09

Justification for single source acquisition (what is necessary and unique about the product, service or source; steps taken to confirm unavailability of competition, as appropriate): The Activu software which operates the video wall system is owned by Activu who does not allow other vendors to have administrative access. For proper troubleshooting software and hardware need to be evaluated together. Having the software and hardware under two contracts in the past has caused many issues with each party deflecting blame and responsibility delaying both vendors from being able to quickly remedy situations. With a combined contract one vendor will be held accountable for all system components and maintenance needs. The Activu software system is proprietary and no other vendor is able to administratively access and troubleshoot the software. In order to do thorough system troubleshooting, it must be a comprehensive approach to considering both hardware and software.
