TECHNICAL QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 1: Vendor will remove the tile wainscot in the restrooms and put new tile up?

Answer: The Vendor is to remove the existing tile and install new tile. The Department will remove wallpaper and fixtures. The Department will also paint the upper bathroom walls.

Question 2: Will all fixtures be brand new?

Answer: No. Vendor will re-use existing toilets, grab bars and ADA sinks. SECTION II, SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED (Addendum 1), Letter K, Vendor shall install FDOT provided grab bars, toilet paper holders, wall mounted soap dispensers, recessed paper towel dispenser and waste receptacle, baby changing stations, 4"x 24" stainless-steel shelves, feminine napkin dispenser, and robe hooks..

Question 3: Who is providing tile flooring?

Answer: SECTION VII, SERVICES/MATERIALS TO BE PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT, Letter C, Floor tile to be provided to the Vendor by the Department.

Question 4: Who is providing wall tile?

Answer: SECTION II, SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED, Letter J, Vendor shall provide and install wall tile, bullnose or Schluter edge, grout, crack membrane, 24" water proofing from the floor and/or any other tile accessory to create a complete assembly.

SECTION IV, VENDOR'R RESPONSIBILITIES, Letter I, Vendor will supply and install wall tile and grout (Dahl Tile Linden point LP 20 Beige, or equivalent) to match existing tile floor in the lobby.

Question 5: Who is installing the partitions in the bathroom?

Answer: The partitions will be purchased and installed by another Vendor.

Question 6: Will the Department be supplying the hand dryer?

Answer: SECTION II, SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED, Letter H, Vendor shall rough-in electrical in new wall of Women's restroom and existing wall in the lobby Men's restroom to accommodate a 110 volt hand dryer. A cover plate will be used at this time. The hand dryer will be installed at a later date.

Question 7: How are we handling the carpeting?

Answer: SECTION IV, VENDOR RESPONSIBILITIES, Letter Q, With respect to construction services in the Transportation Development area, remove two non-load bearing walls, construct two non-load bearing walls and install one existing door and Vendor provided new frame. Also, rework electrical, lighting, heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) and ceiling grid as necessary. Paint all new walls and door frames to match existing and create a complete assembly. (FDOT to provide paint). Vendor shall remove carpet tiles where new wall locations are being built. FDOT will reinstall carpet tiles and cove base.

Question 8: Door frames to be provide by the Vendor.

Answer: Knock down frames are ok to use as long as they match existing and create a complete assembly.

Question 9: Tile on the walls will stay the same height that it is now?

Answer: Yes. The tile will remain the same height that it is now.
