The definition in subsection VII. For "District Four" has been modified to read:

VII. <u>District Four</u>: The FDOT office that is responsible for the geographic areas of Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie and Indian River Counties and the South Florida Rail Corridor (CSX) right-of-way located in Miami-Dade County. Also, may be referred to as "District".
