Q. The RFP requests that a minimum of 12 bridges receive inspection. Have those bridges been identified, and if so what ones are they? If they have not, are those bridges to be identified by the proposer, FDOT, or some other mechanism?

A: FDOT has a record of all of the bridges that have CP installed and several that have been constructed with improved construction techniques. After review of the Bridge Inspection Reports, the FDOT and the Vendor can discuss which 12 bridges to focus on.

Q. Is it correct to state that the study will be limited to reinforced concrete elements on the subject bridges? If not, what other elements are included in the study?

A: The Research will be limited to steel reinforced concrete structures.

Q: The RFP project objective section mentions subsequent evaluations. Is it intended for the proposers to make subsequent evaluations to the 12 bridges? If so, over what time period and how many subsequent evaluations are required per bridge?

A: It is anticipated that at least 2 to 3 subsequent evaluations to be conducted substantially spanning the length of the Contract.
