#	Question	Answer
1	Why were all ITB's rejected for DOH 19-026?	The Department omitted a section from the price page when posting DOH 19-026. To correct this, the Department had to reject all bids and re-bid with the correct price page.
2	What specific changes were made between DOH 19-026 and DOH 19-052?	It is the Respondents' responsibility to read the requirements of DOH19-052, and respond accordingly.
3	Can you confirm or clarify if the "Initial Annual Maintenance Agreement" in your document refers only to the "Initial Warranty and Maintenance" period provided with purchase? Can this be edited to "Initial Two Year Maintenance Agreement"?	The Warranty is provided at no cost to the Department (Attachment A, section H). The Initial Annual Maintenance Agreement will be purchased by the Department and take effect when the initial warranty period ends (Attachment A, section I). No, the language will not be edited.
4	Will the DOH create an additional Price Page format that states "Initial Annual (2) Two Year Maintenance Agreement" and "Renewal for Annual (2) Two Year Maintenance Agreement" on page 25?	No.
5	The ITB declares the Department's right to purchase additional units at the unit price specified in Attachment B. In the event the offeror provides a price "with trade-in", does the Department expect to receive this unit price for future systems even in the absence of future trade-ins?	No, the trade-in price is only indicative of a period where trade-in is feasible. Any future purchase will be based on the price quoted without trade-in.

6	In section 3.8.3.1 the ITB establishes the requirement for "documentation demonstrating equipment stability and reliability". Can you provide any clarification on the documentation you seek? For instance, are internal quality assurance records necessary and sufficient?	See Attachment A, Section C, number 1(n)(2) and number 6.
7	In section 3.10, the ITB requires an attorney's written opinion regarding preferences from a foreign state. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the expense associated with this specialized legal opinion are significant.
