So good afternoon, everyone. GOVERNOR SCOTT: In previous meetings and in accordance with our Cabinet and Governor's Guidelines, our meeting is to appointment the Interim Secretary of the Department of Environmental Protection.

Last week, I nominated Ryan Matthews to serve as the Interim Secretary.

First, I hope each of you have had the opportunity to meet with him.

ATTORNEY GENERAL BONDI: Governor, I did. Τ met with him at length and I was extremely impressed. I think a lot of him.

GOVERNOR SCOTT: Did Commissioner, CFO, did y'all have an opportunity to talk?

CFO ATWATER: Governor, Jeff Atwater here. Ι did. He was very gracious with his time, and again, as the Attorney General said, I was very impressed with his readiness to serve and his eagerness to serve in the State. I am very impressed.

GOVERNOR SCOTT: And how about Commissioner,

did you have an opportunity?

COMMISSIONER PUTNAM: I did. Thank you,
Governor. We spent a lot of time and covered a
pretty wide range of issues, and he's got a grasp
on the hot topics facing Florida and a healthy
respect for the Cabinet process that we've laid out
over the last seven years. And I was also very,
very impressed.

GOVERNOR SCOTT: Good. That's the goal. I think that's what we all hope for.

So Ryan, as well, knows as the Deputy

Secretary of Regulatory Programs at the Department,

and I'm confident he's going to continue to fight

So in accordance with Florida Statutes, I move to appoint Ryan Matthews to serve as Interim Secretary of the Department of Environmental Protection at the same salary as John Steverson had, which is 150, and they would be effective February 4, 2017.

MR. MATTHEWS: Yes, sir, I am, Governor.

GOVERNOR SCOTT: Hi, Ryan.

First off, I just want to make sure, Ryan, you're available for any questions, so let's go

CFO ATWATER: Governor, no further questions. He and I had a good time together, and he was very forthcoming on his responses to questions.

GOVERNOR SCOTT: Great.

And Commissioner Putnam?

COMMISSIONER PUTNAM: Governor, he answered a lot of my questions already, and I'm very comfortable with us proceeding with him in the interim role.

This is Adam Putnam. 4 5 GOVERNOR SCOTT: Are there any objections? 6 ATTORNEY GENERAL BONDT: No. 7 GOVERNOR SCOTT: Okay. So we're unanimous, 8 right? Is everybody okay with it? CFO ATWATER: We are. 10 ATTORNEY GENERAL BONDI: 11 COMMISSIONER PUTNAM: 12 ATTORNEY GENERAL BONDI: Yes, Governor. 13 think he's officially appointed as Interim 14 Secretary of DEP at the same salary as Secretary 15 Steverson was. 16 GOVERNOR SCOTT: Perfect. Okay. So what I can do is, if it's okay with 17 18 everybody, we'll follow the appointment process for 19 permanent. We'll work with the departments to 2.0 advertise the Secretary position with the 21 associations across the country, and we'll publish 22 applications on the Cabinet website. If this works 23 for everybody, we can open the position again this

Monday, February 6, and close it on April 28th, so

we have plenty of time for people to apply. That

will give us plenty of time to review the
application, schedule public interviews and such,
but the goal is that we would appoint if we can -can't guarantee we can -- but it's the goal we make
the appointment on May 23rd Cabinet meeting.

So I hope everybody feels comfortable bringing forth anybody they would like to schedule interviews, and I think the goal would be that we would read — if anybody that anybody would like for all of us to interview at the Cabinet meeting or before, you would bring that to Cabinet Aides meeting. The last day for this my guess would be May 17.

Does that process work for everybody?

ATTORNEY GENERAL BONDI: It works for me,
Governor.

CFO ATWATER: Governor, Jeff Atwater here. It works for me.

GOVERNOR SCOTT: Okay.

COMMISSIONER PUTNAM: I agree. That sounds like a thorough timeline that would allow anyone to hear of this opportunity and go through the process.

GOVERNOR SCOTT: And I think I'll say that and I think everybody would say the same thing. Our

1 expectation is that Ryan, even at this juncture, is the Interim Secretary. And we're going to do a thorough process to find a permanent, but the 3 expectation is that he'll work with all four of us 5 to do the job now. He's not expected to say he 6 can't do things because "I'm not a permanent." The 7 goal is for him to do his job as if he were 8 permanent, and we would go through the process in 9 the next two months and find the permanent. 10 Does that make sense for everybody? 11 ATTORNEY GENERAL BONDI: It does. And 12 Governor, I would love for him to meet with Carlton 13 Ward. Commissioner Putnam and I know Carlton very

And Ryan, he does the wildlife expedition corridor and he's really amazing. If you haven't met with him already, he's a great person regarding Florida Everglades.
