2	Attachment 2: Statement of Work	SOW; page 7; Section 5.2.3; paragraph 3	Summary discussion; Item three says the On-site Coordinator will be provided at least 2 days per week or more as deemed necessary and requested in writing by the Division at no additional cost.	No, coordination and consultation conducted on-site is not billable. Section 5.2.3, paragraph 3, specifically states, “[t]he Contractor shall, at no additional cost to the Division , dedicate one (1) qualified Florida-licensed investigator, for Type III and Type IV service coordination and close consultation with Division staff.” (Emphasis added.)
