The return of the bond shall be conditioned upon the payment of all costs which may be adjudged against the protestor in an administrative hearing in which the action is brought and in any subsequent appellate court proceeding. In lieu of a bond, the Department may except a cashier's check or money order in the amount of the bond. FAILURE TO FILE THE PROPER BOND AT THE TIME OF FILING THE FORMAL PROTEST WILL RESULT IN A DENIAL OF THE PROTEST.
