e. Special Condition 24) Electronic Submission of Replies is here by changed to include the following language:

Respondents may send their reply via the Department's File Transfer Appliance (FTA).

Respondents' requests to submit a reply via FTA must be received at D4CS@dot.state.fl.us at least 3 business days prior to the Reply Due Date for which they are submitting a reply. Two of the three business days are to allow time for the Department to send respondents the link to upload their proposal/reply.
