Question Number	Question	Response
1	Can you give some general guidelines to the number of boxes, type of payments, (ie. taxes, utilities), monthly volumes, and any peak processing periods for the lockboxes?	DMS currently has seven (7) lockboxes and anticipates needing the same number of lockboxes. The types of payments received in these lockboxes are MyFloridaMarketPlace (MFMP) transaction fees, E-911 payments, rent, contract management payments, phone/wireless, and insurance payments. The monthly volume of checks ranges from 4,500 to 7,250, based on the last eleven (11) months. The peak volume is the 1 <sup>st</sup> -15 <sup>th</sup> of each month.
2	Can you provide Lockbox Post office location and # of pick up requirement per day	The current lockbox addresses are Orlando, Florida. As the lockbox services are currently contracted with a banking institution, DMS does not possess the information on how many pick-ups are occurring each day to meet the demand.
3	Please clarify on Volume type - Consumer or Commercial checks or both Primarily consumer.	Both. The checks may derive from individuals or businesses based on the type of payment.

4	Estimated volume per month/annual	The annual volume of checks is estimated to range between 54,000 to 87,000. Please see the answer to question #1 for the monthly volume.
5	Is there a Peak and Off-peak volume during 12-month period	No, the volumes are relatively consistent each month.
6	Is there any compliance audit requirements like PCI DSS etc.,	Νο
7	Is there a requirement for DMS provided courier or can Exela use inhouse courier	There is no requirement for a DMS provided courier.
8	Is there any additional compliance requirements like NIST etc.,	Some of the information may be sensitive and include protected information such as social security numbers and HIPAA information.
