PROCEEDINGS

1
2 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Good morning, before we
3 begin, I want to confirm, are the Cabinet Members on
4 the line?

5 CFO PATRONIS: This is Jimmy Patronis.

6 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay.

7 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Ashley Moody is present.

8 COMMISSIONER SIMPSON: Yeah. And I'm -- and
9 Wilton, I'm present.

10 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. All right. Well,
11 let's go ahead. Our first item is related to minutes.
12 I move to approve outstanding minutes from prior
13 meetings, including our meeting in May. Is there a
14 second?

15 CFO PATRONIS: Second (unintelligible).

16 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

17 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: All right. Hearing no
18 objection, the motion carries.

19 Now, on to appointments, each of our office has
20 received a list of candidates for the Commission on
21 Offender Review and has had time to review and meet
22 with each of them. After that review, I move to
23 reappoint Commissioner David Wyant. Is there a
24 second?

25 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second. This is Ashley

1 Moody.

2 COMMISSIONER SIMPSON: Second.

3 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no -- hearing
4 no objections, the motion carries. Thank you.

5 All right. Department of Revenue Director
6 Zingale, can you present your first item?

7 DIRECTOR ZINGALE: Good morning. Thank you,
8 Governor and Cabinet.

9 This is a short agenda today. The department
10 only has two items on today's agenda. Item one, the
11 department respectfully requests approval to file for
12 final adoption rules related to general tax
13 administration. Request approval.

14 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: I move to approve. Is there
15 a second?

16 CFO PATRONIS: Second.

17 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection,
18 the motion carries.

19 Please present your final item.

20 DIRECTOR ZINGALE: Item two, the department
21 respectfully request approval to publish notices of
22 proposed rules for rules relating to general tax,
23 property tax oversight and child support, and further
24 request approval to file for final adoption if the
25 substance of the proposed rules remain unchanged.

1 Request approval.

2 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Move to approve. Is
3 there a second?

4 CFO PATRONIS: Second.

5 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no
6 objection -- hearing no objection, the motion carries.
7 Thank you very much.

8 Moving to Department of Veterans Affairs, we've
9 got Director Hartsell. Please present your agenda
10 item.

11 DIRECTOR HARTSELL: Good morning, Governor and
12 Cabinet.

13 The department has one agenda item: It's our
14 recommendation for the Florida Veterans Hall of Fame
15 Class of 2023. Our Florida Veterans Hall of Fame
16 honors our military veterans who honorably served our
17 nation and have made a significant contribution to
18 Florida by their civic, business, and public service
19 helping the citizens of our great state.

20 Our Hall of Fame Council met recently to review
21 39 nominations that the public had submitted to the
22 council's consideration for this year's class, and
23 from those 39 submissions, the council selected 20
24 names that they recommended to me for my endorsement
25 and my subsequent submission to you.

1 I fully endorse these 20 veterans that the
2 council selected and whose names are before you, and I
3 respectfully request your approval of these amazing
4 Florida veterans as the Florida Veterans Hall of Fame
5 Class of 2023.

6 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: I move to approve the item.
7 And I want to extend my thanks to each of the nominees
8 for their service to our country. Is there a second?

9 CFO PATRONIS: Second.

10 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

11 COMMISSIONER SIMPSON: Second.

12 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection,
13 the motion carries. Thank you.

14 Moving on to our OIR agenda, which implements
15 bills passed this session through rule. These include
16 the Prescription Drug Reform Act, which institutes
17 accountability standards for pharmacy middlemen known
18 as pharmacy benefit managers, and President
19 Passidomo's priority legislation to increase
20 policyholder protections when filing an insurance
21 claim following a natural disaster.

22 With that, Commissioner Yaworsky, please present
23 your bundled agenda item.

24 COMMISSIONER MIKE YAWORSKY: Thank you, Governor.

25 OIR is requesting approval for publication and

1 final adoption of proposed rules, and if no hearings
2 are requested or no changes are needed, for final
3 adoption.

4 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. I move to approve the
5 item. CFO Patronis, do you second the motion?

6 CFO PATRONIS: Yes, sir. Great work, Governor.
7 Thanks for your leadership on this.

8 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection
9 on this, the motion carries. Thank you, Commissioner.
10 We appreciate it.

11 Now we're going to Bond Finance. Ben Watkins,
12 please present your first item.

13 DIRECTOR WATKINS: Item number one is a
14 \$10-and-a-half million refinancing for University of
15 Florida's student housing, saving the state
16 approximately a million dollars in lower interest
17 rate. Item number two is a resolution authorizing an
18 \$86.7 million financing of a student housing facility
19 at University of North Florida.

20 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: All right. I move to approve
21 that item. Is there a second?

22 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

23 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection,
24 the motion carries. Please present your next item.

25 DIRECTOR WATKINS: Item number three is a

1 resolution selecting municipal advisors for the
2 Division of Bond Finance being recommended pursuant to
3 a competitive selection process.

4 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: I move to approve the item.
5 Is there a second?

6 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

7 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection,
8 the motion carries. Thanks, Ben.

9 Moving to the Board of Trustees, Secretary Shawn
10 Hamilton, please present your items one through three.

11 SECRETARY HAMILTON: Thank you, Governor, and
12 good morning, Trustees.

13 Items one through three are requests to surplus
14 non-conservation properties, accept the highest bid
15 amounts, and to approve contracts for sales. Items
16 one through three include a Delegation of Authority
17 request, and pursuant to statute, the funds received
18 from all three sales will be deposited into the
19 Internal Improvement Trust Fund. The department
20 recommends approval for items one through three.

21 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. I move to approve the
22 items. Is there a second?

23 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

24 COMMISSIONER SIMPSON: Second.

25 CFO PATRONIS: Second.

1 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Third? Okay. Seems like
2 it's unanimous. All right. Hearing no objections,
3 the motion carries.

4 Please present items four through seven.

5 SECRETARY HAMILTON: Items four through seven
6 represent one less-than-fee and three full-fee
7 acquisitions. Combined, these acquisitions total over
8 29,000 acres and will protect natural lands and
9 provide vital linkages for Florida's wide range of
10 wildlife for generations to come. Each of the
11 properties are within the Florida Wildlife Corridor,
12 and three are within the Northwest Florida
13 (unintelligible.) Department recommends approval for
14 items four through seven.

15 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. I move to approve the
16 items. Is there a second?

17 CFO PATRONIS: Second.

18 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

19 COMMISSIONER SIMPSON: Second.

20 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection,
21 the motion carries.

22 Moving to Aquaculture, please present item eight.

23 SECRETARY HAMILTON: Thank you, Governor. Item
24 eight will be presented by Portia Sapp with the
25 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Service,

1 Division of Aquaculture.

2 MS. SAPP: Good morning. Item eight for your
3 consideration is a new two-acre lease requested by
4 Sharkbite Seafood to expand their existing oyster
5 aquaculture business. Staff recommends approval of
6 this item.

7 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. I move to approve the
8 item. Is there a second?

9 CFO PATRONIS: Second.

10 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

11 COMMISSIONER SIMPSON: Second.

12 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: And a third, okay. Looks
13 like it's unanimous. Hearing no objection, the motion
14 carries.

15 Moving on to items nine and ten, Rural and Family
16 Lands.

17 MS. SAPP: Items nine and ten will be presented
18 by Sue Mullins.

19 MS. MULLINS: Good morning, Governor and
20 Trustees. We have two Rural and Family Lands
21 Protection Program projects for you this morning.

22 The first is item nine: Adams Ranch in Osceola
23 County requests to acquire a perpetual conservation
24 easement on 8,820 -- 8,882 acres for consideration of
25 \$26,000,650. The second is item ten, Buck Island

1 Ranch. That's in Highlands County. Another request
2 to acquire perpetual conservation easement. This one
3 totals \$4,490 at the Buck Island Ranch for
4 consideration of 10,104,000.

5 And both are working cattle ranches. They are
6 both enrolled in the best management practices located
7 in the Florida wildlife Corridor and will be monitored
8 by our department's Rural and Family Lands Program.
9 Respectfully request approval of both items, sir.

10 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. I move to approve the
11 items. Commissioner Simpson, do you second that
12 motion?

13 COMMISSIONER SIMPSON: Yes. Second.

14 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection,
15 the motion carries. Thank you.

16 All right. Next agenda item is the
17 Administration Commission. In May, we directed staff
18 to draft and circulate a final order in the proceeding
19 of Melzer versus Martin County. Mark Buckles, please
20 confirm that that order has been circulated.

21 MR. BUCKLES: Yes, Governor, the order has been
22 circulated.

23 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. And then please
24 proceed to the items.

25 MR. BUCKLES: Okay. Well, first, we ask for

1 approval of the order be confirmed as final.

2 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. I move to approve the
3 order as presented. Attorney General, do you second
4 that?

5 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

6 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection,
7 that motion carries.

8 Our final item?

9 MR. BUCKLES: Okay. We have repeal of
10 Administration Commission Rule Chapter 28-42. The
11 rules in this series are obsolete pursuant to
12 legislative action that transitioned this to DOAH.

13 We also have a Department of Management Services
14 request to amend four rules and create one additional
15 rule in Chapter 60L-34 to provide expanded maternity
16 and parental leave benefits for eligible executive
17 branch employees. I ask that the proposed rules be
18 approved for final adoption unless there is a
19 substantial change.

20 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. I move to approve the
21 items as presented. Is there a second?

22 ATTORNEY GENERAL MOODY: Second.

23 GOVERNOR DESANTIS: Okay. Hearing no objection,
24 the motion carries.

25 That concludes today's meeting. Thank you all

1 very much.
